State Teams

The Queensland teams all placed in the top three at their respective championship.

The Under 23 Women's and Men's National Championships were re-introduced in 2015 after not being held since 2008. The Under 23 Men's team won the Laing Harrow Shield for the first time and was the only team to bring home the title in 2015.

Queensland Heat and the Under 19 Women's teams came so close to bringing home the Gilley's Shield and Elinor McKenzie Shield respectively, both putting up a great fight before losing their grand final matches in the 8th innings tie break. The Under 17 Girls and Under 23 Women's teams were also runner's up in their national championship campaign both going down to New South Wales in a regulation game.

Queensland Patriots, Under 19 Men's and Under 17 Boy's teams all finished in 3rd place after playing many hotly contested games during the championship.

Eight individual awards were won by members of the Queensland teams and seventeen were named in a Tournament All Star Team at the completion of the National Championship.

Queensland Heat won the 2015 Southern Cross Challenge and a number of players were recognised for their individual performances by winning selection in the All Star Team.

The achievements of the Queensland teams and individual members don't come without a strong commitment by a number of people including the coaches, managers, statisticians and in particular the player's family and team supporters. Softball Queensland sincerely thanks all those involved for their contribution to the success of our teams.

Australian Representation

Australia continued to produce world class results with the Aussie Spirit winning the bronze medal in the 2014 World Championship and the Aussie Colts (U19 Men) finishing in 4th position.

Our goal is to have 30% Queensland representation in Australian Squads. In 2014/15 Queensland has 32% representation in the Aussie Spirit Squad; 23% in the Aussie Steelers Squad and 24% in the 2015 team to contest the World Championship; 34% in the Under 19 Women's Squad and 35.5% in the 2015 team to contest the World Championship; 25% in the Under 19 Men's and 27% in the Under 17 Girls squad. An Under 17 Boys squad was not selected.

TALENT ID AND DEVELOPMENT PATHWAYS

Regional Academies

Thirteen Regional Academies, Brisbane Metropolitan, Darling Downs, West Moreton, North Coast, Wide Bay, Port Curtis, North Queensland, North West, Central Queensland, South Coast, South East, Moreton Bay and Whitsundays, continue to provide development opportunities and training primarily for under 15 age group but also for the members of Queensland and Australian squads preparing for their participation in the various camps and events.

One hundred and seventy-three athletes aged under fifteen participated in the Regional Academy program. A squad of 28 girls and 28 boys was selected to attend a camp which was held in October in Brisbane in conjunction with the Under 19 Women's State Championship. State team and specialist coaches with Queensland elite players participated in the camp providing guidance and support to the coaches who had been appointed to the Regional Academy teams for the Australian Under 15 Regional Championships. At the conclusion of the camp, the squads were split into teams of equal ability. A policy outlining the participation criteria to be applied was finalised and adopted for the championship. While the focus is on development, it was very pleasing to have the Storm and Thunder teams playing each other in the grand final, with Storm being the victor.

SAL International Friendship Series

Two teams, Queensland Blaze (female) and Queensland Lightning (male) participated in the 2014 SAL International Friendship Series finishing 4th and 6th respectively. The Australian Girls Green team and the New Zealand Boys Development Team won their respective divisions.

Queenslanders Rachel Kraak, Sara Caterson, Eva Carless, Janice Blackman, Ocearna Conaty-Boxall (Queensland Blaze) and Mikayla Gregory (Australia Gold) were named in the ten person All Tournament Team.

In the male division, Dylan Sheehan (Australia Green) won the Best Pitcher award and Mitchell Woodworth (Queensland Lightning) won the Best Batter and Most Valuable Player Awards. Dylan, Mitchell and Mitchell Noonan (Queensland Development) were named in the boy's All Tournament team.

A Talent ID Camp was held at Redcliffe in June 2014. 120 athletes were identified and invited to attend with over 95 accepting the invitation. The camp was conducted by the state team coaches,

Coaching Director and specialist coaches. The camp was open for district association coaches to attend with a number taking up this opportunity.

Elite Program

Softball remains a Partnership Program within the Queensland Academy of Sport (QAS) and provides support for the elite athletes who are members of Australian squads and the Queensland underpinning programs.

The elite program is co-ordinated and delivered by Head Coach Fabian Barlow with support provided by the state team and regional academy coaches. Softball Queensland is responsible for all aspects of the delivery of the program in Queensland. The QAS provides financial support and access to services and facilities for the softball program at both the state and national level. SQI extends our sincere appreciation to the QAS and to our QAS High Performance Director, Troy Ayers, for his support.

Softball Queensland continues to partner with the University of Queensland (UQ) Sports High Performance Unit. UQ provides the strength and conditioning program for the Queensland Heat program.

COACH EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The Coaching Technical Directorate is headed by Lexie Pearce and supported by Mitchell Crawford and Elite Program Head Coach, Fabian Barlow.

Coach education is provided through face to face and on-line formal accreditation courses and also facilitated through the Softball Community Coach program, general workshops and individual mentoring.

Two Course Presenters Courses, Brisbane and Cairns, were conducted with 22 participants. The goal is to have qualified presenters in every district association who will have the responsibility for the delivery of Level 1 and Level 2 courses. Eight presenters have completed all requirements and others are working towards achieving competency.

Six Level 1 and two Level 2 face to face courses were conducted with forty successful candidates for Level 1 and thirteen for Level 2. In addition, 34 coaches renewed their accreditation.

SQI has introduced athletes in the state team program to the coach education



program. The Queensland Patriots team completed a combined Level 1 and 2 course. The result is fourteen members of the team have achieved Level 2 accreditation.

Ninety-eight coaches completed the Softball Community Coach Program including members of the Queensland Under 19 Men and Women's teams.

In January 2015, Softball Australia released the Training to Compete (Level 3) Coach Accreditation Program on-line which offers coaches more flexibility as they work their way through the coach accreditation pathway. It is ideal for coaches living in remote areas.

Monthly Meetings

Meetings were held on the second Thursday of the month by teleconference. The Directorate endeavour to have face to face meetings whenever the opportunity arises e.g. all in one place at State or National Championships, Forums etc. The Directorate is aiming to conduct a meeting via Skype, which has not proved to be very successful so far.

Annual Combined Forum

From the feedback received we believe that the scoring component of our last Forum was successful. Our first session this year included a feedback session as to what delegates would like to see discussed along with our current agenda. The information that came from this session provided additional topics that overflowed our agenda.

With the spread of levels and experience of delegates, we strive to find a common ground where they feel that they are contributing to, as well as benefiting from, the event.

Our practical session was done from a DVD encompassing iScore which most found to be worthwhile. The rules session with Darren Sibraa was beneficial to all with not as many questions for him this year, so possibly more scorers are becoming aware of the benefits of knowing the rules.

Statistics at championships can occasionally cause some concern. Each scorer who attends should be capable of generating statistics for the team coaches and selectors if required. For this reason a level 3 accreditation is required to be a team scorer for a district association team. Some coaches are not having this valuable tool made available to them by the team scorers and district associations need to address this issue. It may be a factor that the coaches do not understand how these statistics can be of benefit and this can be addressed through education.

Pick Up Scorers

A number of associations requested pick up scorers for championships again this year. Once again Brisbane and Logan City provided quite a number of statisticians to fulfil this role.

This information is then forwarded to the national body.

We felt that we had been making progress with the national body but we have hit another hiccup and hope to gain more information from the Forum this year to once and for all get our database up to where it should be and have all agree that this is the one and only correct database to be used.

The issuing of accreditation cards is working to some extent for the lower levels that have been conducted in Queensland.

Website and Facebook Page

Kirsty Andrews has the responsibility for this project and the uploading of resources to the relevant area. More work will continue with this resource for scoring. The new CRM provider may assist as navigating the web was not always an easy task in the past.

History

Development Programs/Clinics/Appointments

Basic Clinics

A number of district associations conducted internal clinics. Once again, few requests were received to conduct Basic clinics. This area received continued attention during the 2014 forum and has become a greater focus with the directorate.

Junior Umpire Clinic

A Junior Umpire Clinic was conducted on 30 November, 2014 to cater for the number of talented junior umpires that have been attending State Championships and Masters events. Initially 31



umpires were invited from South East Queensland Associations to attend clinic during which a range of topics were covered, including development pathways. A session was also conducted for parents to understand the umpiring program's commitment to junior umpires.

Relationship with Education Queensland

The positive relationship between SQI and School Sports continues to be reinforced through the structured umpiring pathway that was developed in 2009. SQI's Umpiring Directorate has provided management crews to State finals of School competition and has again conducted assessment of candidates at these events. Nikita Ireland, Breanna O'Connor and Leilani Shephard were appointed to the National Primary School Exchange in 2015.

International appointments

Queensland has been well represented in the last year with a number of umpires being selected for international appointments:
